

Taps was played at the Fire Station at 08:46am, the time that the first plane hit the North Tower.

Today, as the rain came down, the community of Culpeper, supported by four Virginia SAR Chapters, came together to remember and honor those who lost their lives on the 9th of September 2001. In addition to the eleven SAR Color Guardsmen, participants included the VFW, American Legion, Bugles Across America, Heritage Girls, Culpeper Volunteer Fire Department, Culpeper Police Department, and the Culpeper Sheriff's Office. Taps was played at the Intersection of Davis & Main at 10:03am, the time that the fourth plane, United Flight 93 crashed in a field near Shanksville, PA.


